

Emergency procedures

Fire Alarm

Visitors and volunteers must familiarise themselves with the recommended fire exit routes and the fire action notices which are displayed in all rooms and corridors throughout the school.

If the fire alarm sounds:

- Leave the building calmly and promptly using the nearest available exit as shown on the fire evacuation maps
- DO NOT return to collect any belongings
- Proceed to the main assembly point on the main playground/ bottom end
- If on the field, assemble at the far end of the field
- If you require special assistance in the event of a fire, please inform the school office on your arrival

Lockdown

In the event of a lockdown:

- The alarm will sound intermittently to notify the school that a lockdown procedure needs to commence
- Staff outside or in the Annex will be notified by the use of a walkie talkie and instructed what to do
- If inside, visitors to remain in the Headteacher's office
- All windows to be shut, blinds to be drawn and doors to be locked
- Children and staff will go under tables in their classroom
- Maintain silence where possible

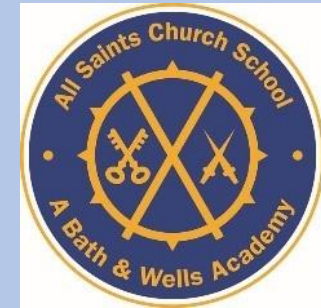
