All Saints Church School Homework Strategy

Our vision

Our homework strategy designed to ensure that every child develops a deep understanding of foundational knowledge, laying a strong foundation for success across the wider curriculum. Pupils, parents and staff have contributed to the strategy and [EEF](#) research has been consulted. We are committed to empowering our children with the belief that consistent effort and purposeful practice lead to meaningful progress and achievement.

We recognise the demands placed on families in today's fast-paced world. Therefore, our homework model emphasises independence, helping children build self-reliance with minimal parental involvement but instant feedback. Teachers utilise the data that online platforms provide to inform our taught curriculum, focusing teacher time on quality first teaching. Each week, there are core tasks that are mandatory, alongside some longer-term optional activities.

Inclusivity is vital at All Saints, so printed versions of homework tasks are available to those who request them.

At school, we assess progress every half term and provide targeted interventions for those who need additional support, ensuring that every child has the opportunity to thrive. Your child may receive individualised tasks to complete, tailored to their needs.

Our structure

In Acorns Class, while children learn to read, it is vital that they continue to be read to as often as possible. We will send home phonics games, flashcards and, when they are ready, books which they can read to you. You will also have access to Oxford Owl online books. [Oxford Owl](#)

Each week, class teachers for years 1-2 will set the following homework:

Reading at least four times per week is highly recommended for all ages and please continue to read to your child as often as possible.

Phonics games and flashcards as appropriate.

Spelling homework on Spelling Shed. (when appropriate) There are games to complete with the week's spellings.

Numbots, moving on to Times Tables Rock Stars (Year 2 when appropriate). [TTRS](#)

Each week, class teachers for years 3-6 will set the following homework:

Reading at least four times per week is highly recommended for all ages and please continue to read to your child as often as possible.

Spelling homework on Spelling Shed. There are games to complete with the week's spellings.

These will be checked on a Friday through dictation (children applying their knowledge).
