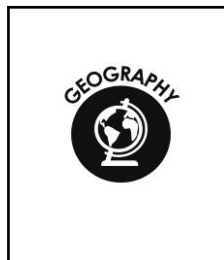
Main Learning: Features of Europe

Eiffel Tower	A famous monument in Paris, France, constructed between 1887 and 1889.
Florence	One of Italy's most famous cities known for its culture, art, architecture and history.
Kremlin	Is in the heart of Moscow in Russia and is the residence of Russian leaders.
Berlin Wall	Was built in 1961 to divide west and east Germany. It became famous for symbolising how east and west Europe differed.
Colosseum	A major landmark in Rome, a reminder of the great Roman Empire.
Barcelona cathedral	Is also known as the Cathedral of the Holy Cross and Saint Eulalia. It is a Gothic cathedral and seat of the Archbishop of Barcelona, Catalonia, Spain.
