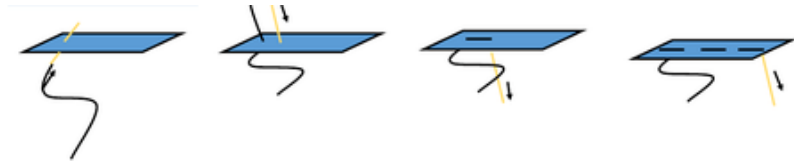
Key Vocabulary

Running Stitch	A simple style of sewing in a straight line with no overlapping.
Sew	To join or fasten with stitches made using a needle and thread.
Knot	A join made by tying two pieces of string or rope together.
Thread	A thin fine cord formed by spinning and twisting short fibres into a continuous strand.
Sampler	Samplers are hand embroidery patterns featuring a variety of embroidery stitches or motifs, borders or letters of the alphabet. Sometimes they're very traditional, other times they're modern.
Cross stitch	
Embroidery	Decorating fabric with decorative patterns
Eye	The part of the needle which the thread goes through

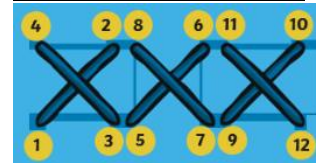


Skills
